The course is suitable for the beginner and does not assume any knowledge of photographic techniques or digital photo-editing skills. It will also appeal to those who want to top up their skills.

WHAT COULD I DO AFTER THE COURSE?

The course provides a foundation that allows you to continue to create and share images that you are proud of as your photographer's eye develops.

If your images are of a high standard, you may wish to try for a qualification or distinction in photography. The course has been designed to give you the necessary basic skills to tackle the Royal Photographic Society Licentiate Distinction (LRPS) in still photography.
